

Author Agreement

License to Publish in a Publication of TheScientificWorld

The act of an author ("the Author") submitting an article ("the Article") to TheScientificWorld grants to TheScientificWorld ("the Publisher") the exclusive publishing and distribution rights according to the following license agreement ("the License"). Please take a moment to read the terms of this License. The corresponding Author represents that all disclosed authors of the submission are in agreement with the terms of the License. This License does not infringe upon the Author's rights under copyright.

The Publisher shall exercise its right at its discretion to have the article peer-reviewed by referees of its or its editors' choosing, even if the article submitted is an invited article by the Publisher's representatives or any of its editors ("the Editors"). The Author promises to respond rapidly to any necessary requests made by the Publisher for revisions of the article following peer-review, after acceptance for publication, and after publication. Authors may receive privileged, confidential and private information, the confidentiality of which should be respected.

If the article is accepted for publication, the Author(s) or other copyright owner(s) agree to grant the Publisher the exclusive right to both publish and distribute the article (including the abstract) throughout the world in electronic, print or any other medium as now or may in the future exist, and to authorize others (including but not limited to Reproduction Rights Organizations such as the Copyright Licensing Agency, the Copyright Clearance Center, and other document distributors) to do the same according to their terms of trading. The Author agrees that the Publisher may publish the Article, and distribute or sell it, on its own, or with other related material according to the Publisher's terms of trading.

"Open Choice" and Open Access

Through its "Open Choice" policy, the Publisher will give the Author an option to make the accepted Article available on "Open Access" free of all subscription or other access charges on the Publisher's website by payment of the Open Access Fee. The Publisher will also offer the Author the alternative option to publish at no cost, whereupon the published Article will be available through subscription and other licensed access at the Publisher's discretion.

The Author warrants that the Article is the Author's original work, has not previously been published, and is not currently under consideration by another journal. The Author also warrants that the Article does not, to the best of the Author's knowledge, contain anything that is libelous, illegal or infringes anyone's copyright or other rights. Authors warrant that they have followed HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) rules and regulations regarding patient information. Authors also warrant that they have followed the Animal Welfare Act. If the article contains material that is someone else's copyright, the Author warrants that the unrestricted permission of the copyright owner to use the material has been obtained, that the Author has submitted evidence of this, and that such material is clearly identified and acknowledged in the text.

The Publisher will respect the Author's rights. The Publisher will make sure that the Author's name(s) is/are always clearly associated with the Article. Should the Publisher or its Editors elect to make editorial changes, no substantial alterations will be made to the Article without consultation with the Author.

Copyright remains with the Author, and the Publisher will acknowledge this in the copyright line that appears on the Article. The Author retains the right to revise and adapt the Article, and prepare derivative works, provided that the published original article is acknowledged in standard bibliographic citation form, including where possible the DOI for the article. The Author may distribute reasonable numbers of the PDF version of the Article to colleagues or associates or transmit a link to the PDF version of the Article hosted by the Publisher's website, provided that recipients are informed that they may not further sell, disseminate widely or copy the Article, and that all use is for personal non-commercial benefit of the Author or other recipients of the Article and does not conflict directly with the commercial business interests of the Publisher. For distribution of an Article to larger lists, the Author or other third party must have the permission of the Publisher. If in doubt, the Publisher should be contacted.

The Author, or the Author's professional institute(s) at the time the work was undertaken, may post a pre-published version of an accepted article in its entirety or in part on the Author's web site providing the definitive final version published by TheScientificWorld is cited upon publication and links are made to the Article page as hosted by the Publisher. The authenticated, validated and definitive version of the Article is the one that is found on the Publishers web site and is the only source that should be cited. The Author may not post the definitive, published version of the Article on any web site, unless you have permission by the Publisher, against which the Publisher may charge a fee to grant such permission at its sole discretion. Any text, tables, figures or supplemental materials from TSW Articles may be used for non-commercial purposes, provided that the source is acknowledged through correct citation as referenced within any article.
